The MSA is committed to the protection of the environment and is championing sustainability through the formalisation of their environmental management system at their operations at MSA headquarters.

It is pursuing a number of measures to ensure it adheres to best practice in environmental performance.

Once established, the system will be developed to include environmental awareness and sustainability at events and a basis for environmental operational excellence in the UK

The progress with the environmental management plan forms part of the executive committee agenda.

Every member of staff at MSA HQ is actively involved in the sustainability programme and receives regular briefings to promote awareness and engagement.

The focus of the programme is as follows:

1. Development of an effective environmental management programme based upon FIAI best practice and ISO 14001
2. Awareness of carbon neutral operations by reference to the use of the Carbon Offset Module as issued by the FIAI
3. Continuous improvement for the development of energy efficiency, project design, recycling and reuse and general environmental awareness
4. The development of the MSA as the central authority for environmental focus within the motor sport infrastructure and facilities in the UK
5. Commitment towards environmental improvement in operations within a resource effective organisation with environmentally aware and motivated staff
6. Awareness of future environmental aspects and risks
7. Effective communication of the MSA environmental management and sustainability programme across the UK motor sport industry
8. Annual review of objectives based on FIAI statutes and codes of practice, the law, and/or other external factors
9. Compliance with laws, legislation and recognised best practices as applicable
10. Reporting on environmental performance in an annual report including carbon emission calculation.
