The MSA is fully committed to a high standard of health and safety management within the organisation and across motor sport in the United Kingdom. The MSA identifies that a comprehensive Health and Safety Management System and Strategy will help identify and minimise potential risks for employees, volunteer officials, competitors and members of the public involved in motor sport in the United Kingdom.

In pursuance of achieving and maintaining such high standards in health and safety:

- The offices and activities of the MSA will be managed in accordance with relevant legislation as applied in the United Kingdom.
- All events must be organised by MSA Recognised clubs and organisations in accordance with the regulations and requirements of the MSA, taking guidance as appropriate from the FIA and so as to respect appropriate statutes and legislation as is applicable within the United Kingdom.
- Identifying clearly defined roles and responsibilities for health and safety within the MSA, for its Recognised clubs and organisations and generally within motor sport in the United Kingdom enables all parties to meet such responsibilities.

A good health and safety management system and strategy is an asset to all parties involved in motor sport in the United Kingdom.
