Section (R) Rallying

Existing Regulation

49.10.3. The fitting of tyres with an aspect ratio of less than 70% is prohibited, as are slick tyres. There must be a moulded tread pattern at least 1.6mm deep over the whole width of the tyre.

Proposed Regulation

49.10.3. The fitting of tyres with an aspect ratio of less than 70% is prohibited, ~~as are~~ **except where documentary period evidence shows that other tyre sizes used in rallying on the particular make and model of car on the particular surface, be that a sealed or unsealed surface, were used.** ~~Slick tyres are prohibited.~~ There must be a moulded tread pattern at least 1.6mm deep over the whole width of the tyre.

Reason:

To allow Historic stage rally vehicles to use the tyre sizes that they used in period.

The previous 70% profile minimum may not have been suitable for all vehicles particularly in the category 4 period where vehicles routinely used a lower profile tyre in competition.
