

TRACK LIMITS (KARTING)

Guidance notes

From 2016 there is a new *MSA Yearbook* regulation, U12.5.3 which states:

‘Any driver leaving the track more than twice, for whatever the reason, may be excluded from the race (Q.14.4.2 applies).’

Q.41.4.2 states:

‘Drivers must use the track at all times and may not leave the track without a justifiable reason. For the avoidance of doubt:

- a) The white lines defining the track edges are considered to be part of the track.
- b) A driver will be judged to have left the track if any wheel of the car either goes beyond the outer edge of any kerb or goes beyond the white line where there is no kerb.’

1. No wheel has gone beyond the edge of the kerb.
2. Wheels (in this case all four) have gone beyond the edge of the kerb
3. Wheels have gone beyond the white line where there is no kerb.
4. Wheels have gone beyond the while line where there is no kerb.
