# Safety Car Requirements 2018

## Applies to Event Safety Module

R 36.5.9. Crew members of each Safety Car must be signed-on Officials, At least one crew member of each safety car team must have attended an MSA Safety Car Training Session.

R 36.5.10 At least one member of the safety car team must have been involved in pre-event planning. All crew members of the team must be fully briefed on the safety plans for the event by this person or another senior event official.

R 36.5.12 Detailed guidelines on MSA Safety Car Roles and Responsibilities are published on the MSA website which supplement the above requirements.

Part two of the MSA Safety Car Workshop is optional

All Safety Car crew members **MUST** have undertaken the on-line accreditation modules prior to attending the workshop.

# Applications and Registration

---

- Applications will only be accepted from events via Clerk of the Course nominations
- Each CoC will be able to nominate individuals from their safety car teams to attend the programmes. *These individuals MUST have a role which is expected to be part of the Safety Car team during 2018 or 2019.*
- Once nominated, each individual Clerk will be sent a link to forward to their nominees which will provide them with the ability to access and complete the registration form where they will select their dates.
- Registration will be available for the Event Safety Module of the Safety Car Workshops via this process.
- Registrations for each date will close 2 weeks prior to the workshop OR when the workshop is full.
- Once the registration is completed, delegates will receive their joining instructions along with maps and further information about accommodation should it be required.
- *The Driver Skills Module will have a separate application process.*



# Recognition, Renewal and Refresher

---

## **Recognition**

- On successful completion of the Event Safety Module, delegates will receive a signed certificate as well being asked to register as a Licensed Official (if not already) and to have Safety Car Crew added.

**Renewal** will follow the usual MSA procedure

**Refresher** training will be required every three years, this will usually be via an on-line module and an email will be sent with all the relevant information at the due time.
