

Motorsport UK Anti-Alcohol Testing

You may be selected for alcohol testing. Alcohol testing is essential to safety in motor sport. The presence of any alcohol in a Participants body during Competition is prohibited.

Motorsport UK has established the Regulatory right and framework to conduct screening tests for alcohol intoxication at all Permitted Events. These Regulations are contained within the current General Regulations (H.39.2 and G.15.1.4 and G.5.2.16 and G.2.4.10 and G.5.3.1 and D.25.1.14).

What are the control proceedings?

- Motorsport UK and AlcoSense will provide and maintain the equipment.
- One breathalyser for the initial test.
- Another breathalyser for the confirmation test (to be carried out if the reading is equal or greater than 0.01%BAC.
- Alcohol testing will be performed by the designated Anti-Doping Control Official (ADCO) and Chaperone.
- Testing period -3 hours before driving activity **OR** -until 30 minutes after driving activity

What is the testing procedure?

- The Participant shall select a sealed mouthpiece among the selection of mouthpieces that is offered by the ADCO and insert it into the Breathalyser.
- The ADCO shall then instruct the Participant to blow steadily and forcefully into the mouthpiece until an adequate amount of breath has been obtained.
- Any failure or refusal to follow the instructions given by the ADCO shall be considered a breach of the Regulations and the ADCO shall immediately refer the matter to the Stewards for disqualification from the Event.
- The ADCO shall show the Participant the test result displayed.
- If the Screening Test shows a Negative Reading the ADCO shall inform the Participant that the test is over.
- If the Screening Test shows a Positive Reading the ADCO shall perform the confirmation test.
- Anyone who fails the test is not permitted to participate further in the Event until a sample below the Zero Alcohol Level has been provided. The Participant may request a re-test 30 minutes after the failure, or sooner if the next driving activity is within 60 minutes.
- The alcohol testing reading will be documented on the Participants Motorsport UK membership record.
