VOLUNTEER OFFICIALS' & ORGANISERS COMMITMENTS

I WILL:

recognise that drag racers are young children and will treat them appropriately

create a welcoming, friendly and safe environment for everyone

treat every participant fairly and encourage others to do so

recognise that as a representative of the sport, I have a duty to be polite and treat all competitors, volunteers and supporters with respect

PARENT'S & GUARDIAN'S COMMITMENTS

I WILL:

not put pressure on my child to take part

encourage my child to have fun and enjoy drag racing

not impose my own ambitions on my child

not expect my child to win and recognise that the benefits of participation lie in the skill acquisition and not about winning events and championships

promise not to criticise my child if they make a mistake

remember that these drivers are very young and treat them accordingly

never encourage my child to break or bend the rules

respect other competitors and their families and applaud their success

respect the decisions of the officials at all times

RACERS' COMMITMENTS

I WILL:

race for fun

try my best

compete fairly

be polite and treat

everyone with respect

not show off if I win

not get upset if I don't win

TEAMS' COMMITMENTS

WE:

accept that drag racing is primarily about fun

will not put pressure on young racers to achieve results

recognise that participation is about skill acquisition, not about winning events and championships

will never speak or behave inappropriately to a driver

will encourage all participants to respect the rules and the authority of the officials

will never encourage a competitor to break or bend the rules, nor to drive in a manner that could cause injury to themselves or others

recognise that this is not Formula 1

respect the decisions of the officials at all times
