

Marshalling Abroad – Frequently Asked Questions

1. I have been asked to Marshal at an overseas event, what do I need to do?

You will need a declaration from Motorsport UK confirming the Marshal grades that you hold as the Event Organisers may ask for this before they confirm your place on their Marshal team. To obtain this declaration, you will need to complete an online application form, which can be found [here](#). Please ensure you put your correct email address on your application form as your declaration will be emailed to you, should your application be successful.

2. Why would my application be unsuccessful?

Applications will not be accepted if you only hold a Trainee Marshal grade(s) or if you do not have a valid Marshal Licence i.e. the date has expired, and you have not renewed. You will be informed if your application is unsuccessful.

3. Is there a deadline for submitting my application to Marshal abroad?

We recommend that you submit your application as soon as you register to Marshal at an event overseas. Different event organisers will have different policies, and some may ask to see your declaration upon registration, or some may ask to see it when you sign on at the event. It is best to be prepared.

4. I didn't realise I needed a declaration and my event is next week, what do I do?

Please contact us by phone as soon as you can, and we will do our best to process your application as a priority for you. Marshalling abroad applications are processed by the Executive Services Team at Motorsport UK with grading queries being handled by the Education & Training Team.

5. Who should I contact if I have a question about Marshalling abroad?

If your query is about the declaration i.e. you have not yet received your declaration, there is an error on the declaration you have received or if you need it urgently, please ask for the Executive Services Team on 01753 765000. If your query is regarding an unsuccessful application or about the grades needed to gain a declaration, please ask for the Education & Training Team on 01753 765000.

6. Do I have to pay a fee for the declaration?

No – the application to Marshal abroad and the declaration is free.

7. I would like to get involved in marshalling abroad – how do I find out more?

You would need to contact the Event Organiser directly and this information should be available online. Alternatively, your club may be able to help, or you could contact the British Motorsport Marshals Club - visit their website [here](#).

8. I am currently collecting signatures in my Personal Record Card as part of a Marshal upgrade. Can event attendance signatures from events overseas go towards my upgrade?

Overseas event attendance signatures **cannot** be used towards your upgrade with Motorsport UK. If you have attended an FIA sanctioned event abroad, your event signature however can be used towards your grade maintenance requirements.
