

## Personal Record Cards Guidance Notes – Kart, Race and Speed disciplines

### Attendance Signatures

#### 1. Who can sign the Personal Record Cards (PRCs)?

The Post Chief on your Marshal duty post, a Post Chief on an adjoining Marshal post, an acting Post Chief, the Chief Observer, the Chief Flag Marshal, the Chief Marshal or the Clerk of the Course.

#### 2. When can the PRCs be signed?

Towards the end of the day, where the Marshal has been observed for a suitable length of time to be able to evaluate and observe their skills accurately.

#### 3. Where can the PRCs be signed?

At the event.

#### 4. What actions are required and by who?

The Marshal is required to fill in the date, venue and duty boxes. The Post Chief (or appropriate signatory as mentioned above) to complete Post Chief with initial, Motorsport UK ID Number and give any relevant comments.

#### 5. Why must the PRCs be signed?

An attendance signature should only be given if it is viewed by the Post Chief/Appropriate Authoriser that the Marshal's duties were performed to an acceptable standard and for an appropriate amount of time (minimum of 6 hours under racing conditions). If duties are not performed to an acceptable standard, this section is not to be completed but comments are to be made in the additional comments section at the rear of the PRC.



## Training Signatures

1. Who can sign the PRCs?

Any Motorsport UK Trainer delivering the training or the Training Coordinator.

2. When can the PRCs be signed?

When the respective modules have been completed or at the end of the training event.

3. Where can the PRCs be signed?

At the training event.

4. What actions are required and by who?

The Marshal is required to fill in the date and venue (guidance can be given by the Motorsport UK Trainer if needed). The Trainer/Training Coordinator to initial next to all modules completed satisfactorily on the day. These must be signed off individually and not as a block signature. A training signature should only be given if it is viewed by the Trainer/Training Coordinator that the training modules were completed successfully.

## Upgrade Signatures

### 1. Who can sign the PRC?

The Examining Post Chief conducting the assessment.

### 2. When can the PRC be signed?

When it is felt by the Examining Post Chief that the duties being examined have been completed to an appropriate extent.

### 3. Where can the PRC be signed?

On an event following a successful assessment.

### 4. What actions are required and by who?

The Marshal is required to fill in the date and venue prior to handing their PRC to the assessor. The Examining Post Chief to initial next to assessment duty if successfully completed and add comments. An assessment should only be signed off if it is viewed by the Examining Post Chief that the duties were performed successfully and to an acceptable standard. If the assessment is not to an acceptable standard, then the reasons must be explained during a post event debrief and recorded in the *Upgrade Signatures* comments block and the *Additional Comments* section at the rear of the PRC.

## Additional Points

- You cannot obtain signatures for the next upgrade until you have completed the previous one. For example, if you wish to upgrade from Trainee Marshal to Track Marshal and have completed your signatures but are awaiting your assessment, you cannot obtain signatures for the next upgrade from Track Marshal to Experienced Marshal until the grade of Track Marshal has been allocated by Motorsport UK.
- Should the authoriser not consider your performance on the day to be to an acceptable standard, then this should be noted in the *Additional Comments* section at the rear of the PRC.
- Post Chiefs/Authorisers are to check the *Additional Comments* section of the PRC for comments made at previous events prior to signing off any attendance/training events.
