



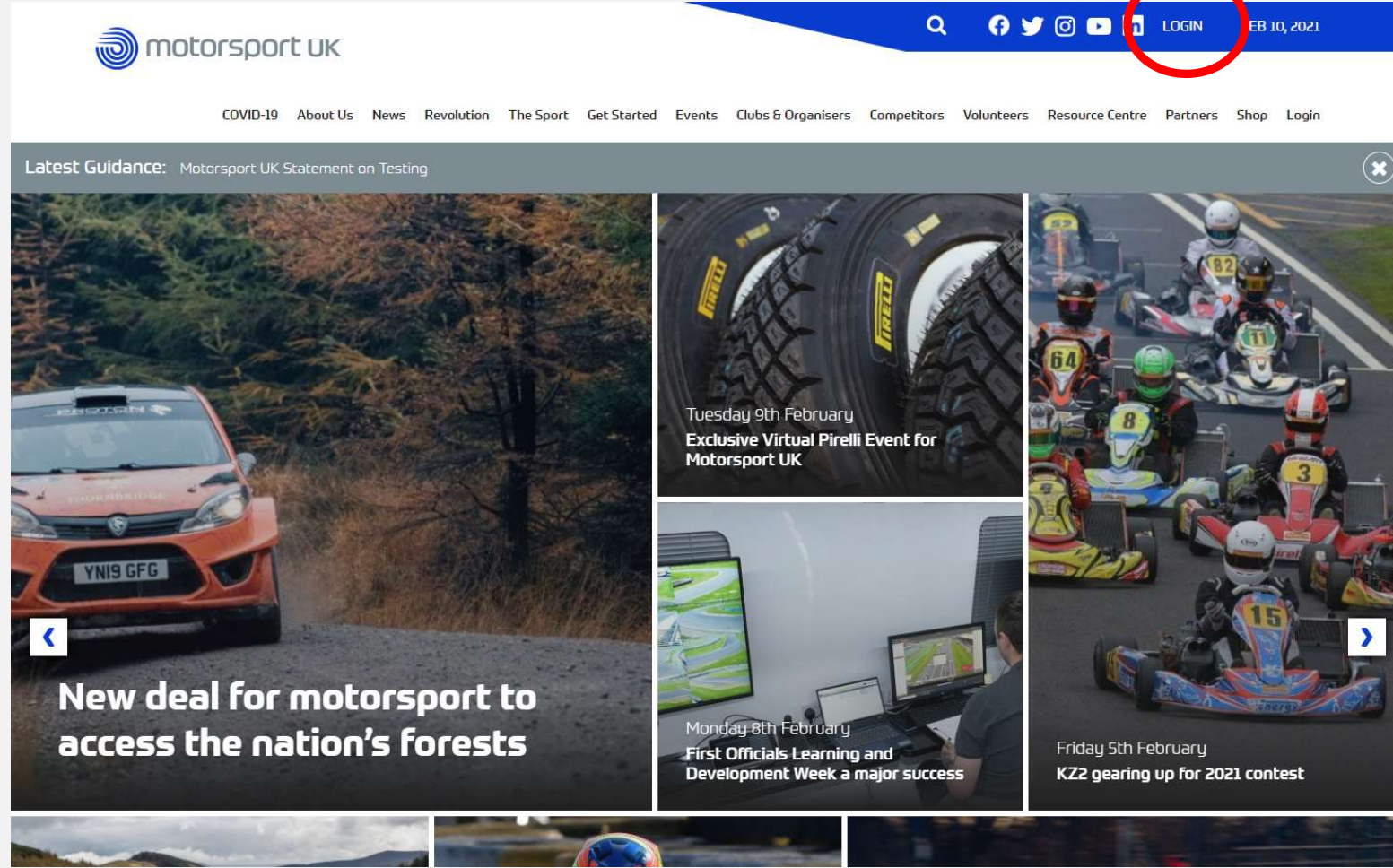

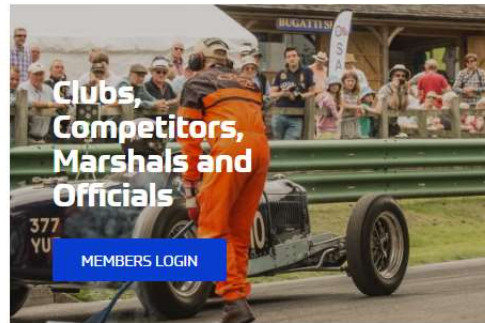
Click on Members login.

Application process



- Complete the online module and download your certificate
- Complete the worksheets
- Apply via the online form <https://forms.gle/P9Xbeu1ABnzbRUw39> - You will need a pdf copy of your worksheets and any other relevant documentation such as screen grabs from your website or regulations to evidence your relevant communication processes
- The panel will review applications regularly
- If successful – you will receive the accreditation logo and guidelines to use on all your communications, clothing, etc. PLUS a grant of £250 towards an environmental project applicable to your event, club or local area
