Motorsport UK does not regulate esports except on particular cases where an esports competition is linked to a Championship or Series that is operated under a Motorsport UK Permit. Accordingly to that extent Motorsport UK is not responsible for the content of games or the conduct of them or the entity offering it to the esports community.

On the Motorsport UK Esports website there is a 'Communities' section. This page is designed to introduce esports users to different communities and companies that Motorsport UK understand to be safe, fair and fun places to interact with esports. These can be communities for different racing platforms, leagues/championships, companies providing hardware or software or driver coaching & setups.

The list of communities and entities is not exclusive. Esports gamers are recommended to carry out their own due diligence regarding financial and general esports practices and data protection.

In order to ensure that these entities are as safe as they can be and are run in a professional manner that would be expected by Motorsport UK if esports was regulated by us, there is a list of criteria that are considered prior to listing.

This is not an exclusive or definitive list and any esports entity can apply to be placed on it. Applicants do not have to meet all listing criteria depending on the nature of offering however this a demonstration of basic due diligence carried out before listing any third party organization and we reserve the right to apply additional criteria or to decline listing.

- Registered as a limited company in the UK with no current statutory Filing defaults
- Discord server having high levels of moderation selected and prohibition of NSFW content
- Motorsport UK may have used them for their own activations and projects
- Rules and regulations implemented for leagues and championships
- Enforce driving standards rules
- Having young persons safeguarding in place to the extent possible
- Provide a product or service that aims to improve or add value to the esports industry
- Innovative product or service
- Helps beginners enter esports
- Replicates real-world motorsport such as rules and regulations & driving and conduct standards
